### Biography

Fred Rogers was born in London and moved to Gt Yarmouth at the age of 7 years (when one could almost cross the river by walking on Scottish trawlers).

He went to Greenacre/ Wroughton Junior schools and then to the Gt Yarmouth Grammar School. Many happy hours were spent in holiday jobs ranging from photography to bingo! From there he went to college and then to a local chartered accountant' s for training.

Five years later he finished training and joined Brown and Root in 1968 as an accountant, rising to Chief Accountant by 1971. These were the heady (and good old) days of early North Sea Gas Construction when the emphasis was on urgency, no matter the cost!!

He was transferred in 1974 to the Taylor Diving subsidiary as Administration Manager for the Middle East, based in Bahrain.

In 1976 he was then offered and accepted a job in Aberdeen as Managing Director of Samson Ocean Systems, who provided Diving and Mooring Services. The company was taken over in 1978 and he joined Mobil North Sea as Contracts Manager.

This wasn' t exciting enough and after a year he joined the major inspection company Oilfield Inspection Services as the Aberdeen Director and General Manager, the company going public in 1982.
